Besides the scientific education of Course and Concours Designers, as already practised since 2004/2005, we have learned from our participants and students, that there is worldwide a need to "TRAIN TALENTED JUNIORS, YOUNG RIDERS, AMATEURS AND TRAINERS" on possibly "Highest Olympic Level".

#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE FORUM**

The 3<sup>rd</sup> WORLD JUMPING FORUM • WJF is based on the following premises

- 1 Take advantage of the superior Equestrian Facilities of CHIO Aachen incl. First Class Stables, incl. presentation CHIO by Frank Kemperman
- 2 Take advantage of the Knowhow-Intensity of the Western European Area and present leading Olympic Medallists and International Champions as Trainers and Lectors
- 3 Invite Qualified Participants from all over the World. Missing horses will be organised locally (f.e. Helena Stormanns, Peter Weinberg or other) on a high level
- 4 Date: beginning of January, when there are mostly no important international Competitions
- 5 Mixture of theory and practice
  - each day 3 theoretical lectures in the morning
  - each day 2 Training Sessions in the afternoon
- 6 Rest day for horses
- 7 All participants in the same hotel, 5 minutes from the Showground
- 8 Open discussions, intercultural exchange and working together and promoting students in the direction of their best talents in an atmosphere of friendship and excellence (Principles of the PLATON-ACADEMY).
- 9 Networking: Participants will be able to get new world-wide contacts
- 10 And at the end, when you go home, you will be an important part of the AACHEN SCHOOL OF COURSE DESIGN.
